

Dr. William R. Huckle

Dr. William R. Huckle is an associate professor of cell biology and pharmacology in the Department of Biomedical Sciences and Pathobiology in the Virginia-Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine at Virginia Tech. Huckle received his M.S. in biochemistry from Virginia Tech, his Ph.D. in pharmacology from the University of Iowa, and post-doctoral fellowship training in cancer cell biology at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill. Prior to joining the faculty of the college in 1999, he was a research scientist at Merck & Company in West Point, Pennsylvania. Huckle is a widely published author in areas of intracellular signaling mechanisms, the regulations of growth factor receptor expression, the maintenance and growth of blood vessels in cardiovascular disease and cancer, and the transgenic models of human diseases. In addition, Huckle is a member of several professional organizations including the American Chemical Society, the Endocrine Society, the American Society for Cell Biology, the North American Vascular Biology Organization, and the RNA Society.
