

## **Dr. Willard H. Eyestone**

Dr. Willard H. Eyestone is a research associate professor of reproductive biology and biotechnology in the Department of Large Animal Clinical Sciences in the Virginia-Maryland College of Veterinary Medicine at Virginia Tech. He received his M.S. in 1981 and his Ph.D. in 1989 from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. In addition, he did post-doctoral research at Leiden University in The Netherlands. Prior to joining the college in 2000, he was a senior research scientist at PPL Therapeutics in Blacksburg, VA. His research interests are the developmental biology of laboratory and domestic animals, animal cloning by somatic cell nuclear transfer, genetic modification of animals for resistance to prion diseases, and embryonic stem cell biology. Eyestone is a member of the Society for the Study of Reproduction, the Society for Developmental Biology, and the International Embryo Transfer Society.
